17	agenda to add, before item No. 2, medical
18	trust, the approval of the board minute

20	February 18, 2019, and March 4th, 2019.

22	MS. HOLMES: That's fine.
23	CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: I make a motion.

1	CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: Okay. All in
2	favor by saying aye.

4	MS. HOLMES: Aye.
5	CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: Okay. All right.
6	Next item, approval of board meeting minutes

12	CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: Okay. I don't

14	I make a motion we approve the regular
15	minute meetings the regular board meeting
16	minutes for February 18, 2019, and March
17	4th, 2019.
18	May we have a roll call, Ms. Bonds?
19	MS. BONDS: Ms. Holmes?
20	MS. HOLMES: Yes.
21	MS. BONDS: Mr. Washington?
22	CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: Yes.
23	With two yes, motion carries for
24	approval of those minutes.
25	Item 2, medical trust.

1	Madam Trustee?
2	TRUSTEE ROBINSON: Mr. President and
3	Board Member Holmes, thank you for coming.
4	I know this was a last-minute meeting called
5	by myself in order it really is
6	informational only. It's a resolution that
7	needs to just be presented to you on behalf
8	of the Trustee, myself.
9	It is a collective effort that was led
10	by North Township Trustee Mrvan. It was
11	introduced to us about two years ago in the
12	effort to get insurance levels at an
13	affordable price for all employees. It just
14	simply broke my heart last year when we had
15	some employees with family members,
16	children, who had to forego insurance
17	because they could not afford it.
18	So we had, again, been introduced to
19	J.A. Benefits, which is the
20	broker/administrator of this plan. And
21	finally we got it together. It is North
22	Township, Calumet Township and Brown
23	Township and Morgan Brown Township
24	Trustee and Morgan County, Indiana.
25	St. John was on with us, but because she

was a newer, just recently-elected trustee, she decided that she and the two other employees did not want to.

So what I'm saying basically is right now we're at a number of over 100, which beats our 43 people any day. You like strength in numbers; right? So we're just asking -- we're just being inclusive in presenting this to you. We've made our first payment. It was not any more than we've paid already. And we won't really see the benefit of it maybe until next year or the year after when all of the monies are collected and all of it comes from the trust, no longer from us.

And they -- and we're always open -right now, as I said, it's three trustees,
three townships, but we're always open -always open -- to collect or to have other
trustees enter as we continuously work to
offer this to anyone else in township
government.

Ms. Smith, as the Chief Deputy, H.R. enforcer, all of the above, has been the key person and been online and just working this

out, but if you have any questions or if she 1 would like to say anything else that I have 2 not covered --3 MS. SMITH: You did an excellent job. 4 5 Thank you, Mr. Robinson. TRUSTEE ROBINSON: I know, б Mr. President, you had a question earlier 7 that I think we got an answer from the 8 attorney --9 CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: Yes. 10 TRUSTEE ROBINSON: -- who is dealing 11 with it as we spoke. Attorney Williams did 12 also look over this, and we also had Steve, 13 who's not available, Steve Dalton, our CPA, 14 15 look over it. He was very congratulatory in our efforts to make this work for everyone. 16 Okay. 17 CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: Ms. Holmes, do you 18 have any comments? 19 MS. HOLMES: Well, I work out at U.S. 20 Steel, and there was a problem, you know, 21 with insurance. And it is hard to find good 22 insurance. And for some reason they keep 23 going back and forth. The company did not 24 want us to have insurance, but we fought, 25

and we got our insurance. So I know how important insurance is, especially with the families.

TRUSTEE ROBINSON: Right.

CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: I just want to commend you, Madam Trustee, Chief Deputy, for doing this and working collectively with other townships because many of your strikes -- Jackie knows this -- is really not over pay. It's the insurance. And companies now -- we have some very good insurance, but companies now are switching. It's not like it used to be. So you all have to be commended.

And again, it's because of my ignorance of knowing about insurance that I asked about that clause. When I see stuff with Griffith and all this other kind of stuff, I just want to make sure there ain't no tricks being thrown in behind the scenes.

And Attorney Williams, you -- with that information we got from the attorney, that cleared that up. So I want to thank you all and congratulations on doing that and helping out the employees of Calumet

Township. 1 MR. WILLIAMS: Very good. 2 TRUSTEE ROBINSON: Thank you. 3 CHAIRMAN WASHINGTON: So do you have 4 anything else? 5 TRUSTEE ROBINSON: I just want to 6 mention again the job fair that will be 7 happening next Tuesday. We have over -- and 8 Ms. Pruitt can speak to this. She's worked 9 very hard on it. We have over 30 employees. 10 I might even go myself to see what I can 11 pick up on the nighttime. And we have over 12 30 employees, so if you guys are free on 13 that day, come out, stop by the 14 multi-purpose center. 15 She and Ms. Niese -- actually, it's 16 their thing, and Ms. Sandy Cogan. So if you 1.7 guys -- you're more than invited. We put it 18 out in enough time. As you see, we started 19 it, months -- or earlier the prior month as 20 soon as we got the date. And people have 21 been sharing it and sharing it. They read 22 it at my church Sunday. I think some other 23 churches did as well, so -- and they 24 mentioned it on WLTH, I heard, so --25

24	it after he thought he was going to be able
25	to make it, but that would be my only

1	consideration. We like the 4:00 o'clock
2	hour. That way it we're here. Gives
3	staff members a moment to come up and join
4	us, and there's no after work compensation
5	to be asked for, so I'm just playing.
6	They don't ask for it, but okay. That's it.
7	Thank you again for your help.
