23	CHAIRWOMAN HOLMES: So next on our						
24	agenda is the Board of Finance report.						
25	MR. DALTON: Madam Chair, can I						

explain? Would that be okay?

CHAIRWOMAN HOLMES: Sure.

MR. DALTON: You have in your packets a landscaped five-page document, which is a preliminary financial report on the year of 2022. You'll recall that in February we will look at the full annual financial report, the 40-page document that you're going to get in your packet next month. This is a very preliminary summary of last year's activities. The only statutory requirement is that we report, as the trustee, to you as the Board how much money was made in investment revenues. You'll find that answer on the second page, which is kind of the inside of the first page.

And you'll note, if you look at the very last column, in 2022 we had a substantial increase in interest earnings. Interest rates went up, that's why. The Trustee's office has done a good job of managing those dollars, your property tax dollars and the taxpayers' dollars, to such an extent that the earnings went up from \$8,700 to \$129,000 in a single year. So, kudos to the team. That is the

1	only thing that is required to be reported to						
2	you. The rest of the document is just a						
3	preview of what we'll go over in February, and						
4	I would ask that you adopt the resolution						
5	attached that says you have reviewed the						
6	report.						
7	CHAIRMAN SMITH: Thank you very						
8	much.						
9	MR. PIGGEE: I have a question. You						
10	said it went up a hundred and how much?						
11	MR. DALTON: \$120,000 in one year.						
12	MR. PIGGEE: Now where does that						
13	come from?						
14	MR. DALTON: Interest. You've got						
15	cash sitting in the bank and the bank is						
16	paying you interest on the cash.						
17	MR. PIGGEE: So the 120 and some						
18	thousand is interest.						
19	MR. DALTON: Interest earnings.						
20	MR. PIGGEE: Okay. Thank you.						
21	MR. DALTON: Yes.						
22	MR. PROTHO: I make a motion that we						
23	accept the finance report as indicated.						
24	MR. PIGGEE: I second it.						
25	MS. CUNNINGHAM: Okay. Roll call.						

1	Mr. Piggee?					
2	MR. PIGGEE: Yes.					
3	MS. CUNNINGHAM: Mr. Protho?					
4	MR. PROTHO: Yes.					
5	MS. CUNNINGHAM: Ms. Holmes?

20	it before a certain date?					
21	MR. DALTON: Before the 20th.					
22	ATTORNEY MONROE: Do you guys want					
23	it on the first Monday or would you rather go					
24	into the second Monday so we don't run into					
25	the holiday again?
